

LADIES CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Competitions shall be played in accordance with the R & A Rules of Golf subject to local rules that are in force on the day of which the competition takes place.

Major trophies and Board events must be played off the Red back markers.

Ties: All ties will be decided by count back EXCEPT Gross Champions in Club Championships where ties will be decided by sudden death playoff. Holes to be played will be decided by Match Committee.

All Finals and playoffs will be attended by a Referee.

DAILY EVENTS:

Thursday Competition from 8.00 am (seasonal).

Entry fee: 18 holes - \$6 - \$7 on Golden Shot days (Golden Shot on 1st Thursday of each month, compulsory entry).

9 holes - \$4 - \$5 on Golden Shot days.

To enter a competition, prior to teeing off, players must register in Booking Timesheet and entry fee paid to the Golf Shop attendant.

Players must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to hit off time, otherwise place in the field may be forfeited.

Competition times are firm unless directed by Match Committee.

A 9 holes Competition will be held in conjunction with the daily event. You must register in Booking Timesheet your preference before the start of play. No player that enters in 18 holes competition will be entered in the 9 holes competition if 18 holes are not completed.

Saturday Competition:

Entry fee: 18 holes - \$7 (includes Golden Shot) 9 holes - \$4.

Book your name in Timesheet (at any available time slot).

Game of the day will be listed in Fixture Book and in Timesheet.

Tuesday Competition: 9 Holes from 11.45am. Entry Fee - \$4 Book into Timesheet.

LADIES THURSDAY CLUB DAY HEAT POLICY:

If the forecast is for 34 – 36 degrees, the competition will be automatically reduced to 9 holes.

If the forecast is for 37 and above, the competition will be cancelled.

Forecast will be taken from BOM Geelong at 2pm on the day prior to competition (Wednesday).

All lady members will be notified via email ASAP if competition has been shortened or cancelled.

*Our lady members' health and safety is of utmost importance and the above conditions may still be too hot for some, so please consider carefully your choice whether to play or not to play.

*Tuesday 9 holes competition will be automatically cancelled if forecast (2pm Monday) is for 33 and over.

NOTE: Player may win Medal and daily event.

FOURBALL MATCHPLAY KNOCKOUT:

Entry fee - \$12 per pair and must be paid prior to entry closing date.

Field capacity – 8 pairs.

SINGLES MATCHPLAY KNOCKOUT:- Captains Trophy

Entry fee - \$6 per player and must be paid prior to entry closing date.

Field capacity – 16 players.

NOTE: Full conditions for all Board events will be available prior to entry opening date.
